Generosity often feels like a burden, but that's not what God intends for it to be. Instead, generosity can set us free, connect us to Kingdom purpose, change how we see our lives, and connect our hearts to the next generation.

Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share.
