Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What group of people do you feel most "at home" and connected with?

Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Has a connection with another person ever changed your life? How so?
- Talk about a time when you drifted toward isolation. What do you think caused that drift?
- Read Ephesians 2:19-22. What does it say about God that He desires to give us a place to belong?

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Sam encouraged us to remember the faithfulness of God, rely on God's people, and release the power of our stories. What are some ways you can start doing those things?
- What are some ways you can fight the drift toward isolation?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Father, thank You for valuing connection. Thank You for reaching out to establish a relationship with us, and thank You for encouraging us in our relationships with others. Help us value these relationships like You do. In Jesus' name, amen.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
