Choose a question to create openness.

- Share about a time when you had to choose between your convictions and what was convenient. Which option did you choose, and what did you learn from that experience?
- Is there an area of your life where you're tempted to follow the world's influence? Talk about ways you can stay rooted in God's will.

Start Praying

Lord, thank You for being our refuge and our stronghold. We want to honor You in every area of our lives. Please help us to stand firm in who You have called us to be, and to love others well. In Jesus' name, amen.
