

Week 1: The Hidden Treasure

Main Passage: Matthew 13:44

Starting Point

- What moment or quote from the message stuck with you most? Why?
- When have you felt like you were “spiraling”—confused, disoriented, or lost?
- The man in the parable wasn’t searching for treasure, but he stumbled into something life-changing. Have you ever experienced unexpected clarity or joy in a hard season?

Digging In

- What kinds of things have you held dear in the past that lost their value once you found something better in Christ?
- In the message, we talked about how spiraling can actually be a blessing in disguise. How does that idea challenge how you see your struggles?
- The man in the parable didn’t just find treasure—he went all in. What would “selling everything” look like for you right now?
- Read Philippians 3:8–9. What does it mean to you to “count everything as loss” in light of knowing Jesus?
- Which of the three actions—**Right Size, Reorient, Return**—do you feel most drawn to in this season? Why?

Living It Out

- What might it look like for you to “go back to the field” this week—to rediscover joy in Jesus?
- What do you sense God asking you to surrender in order to dig again?
- How can you make space this week to remember your first love and do the things you did at first?
